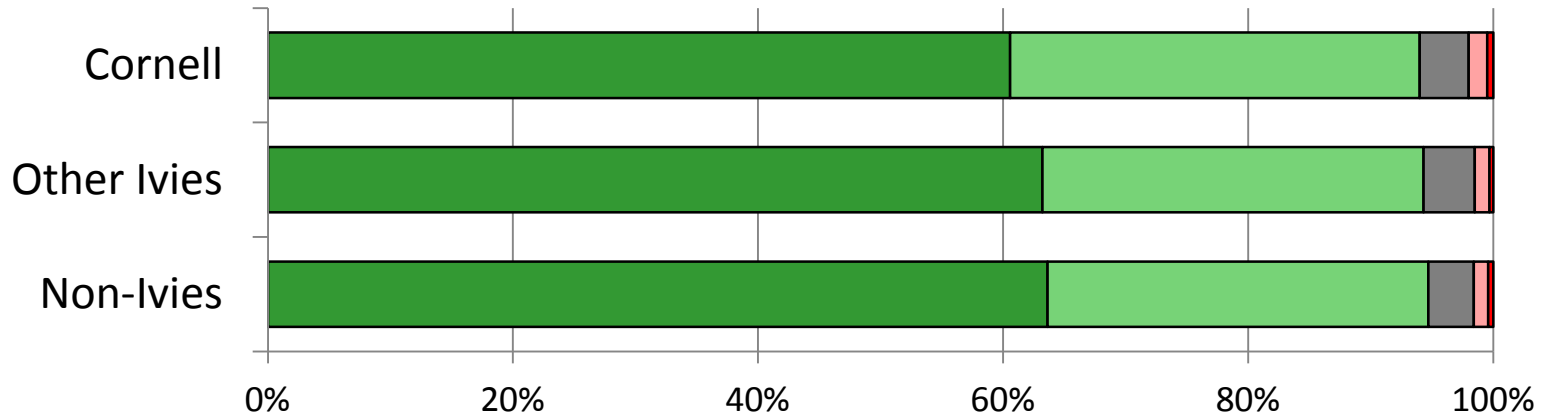

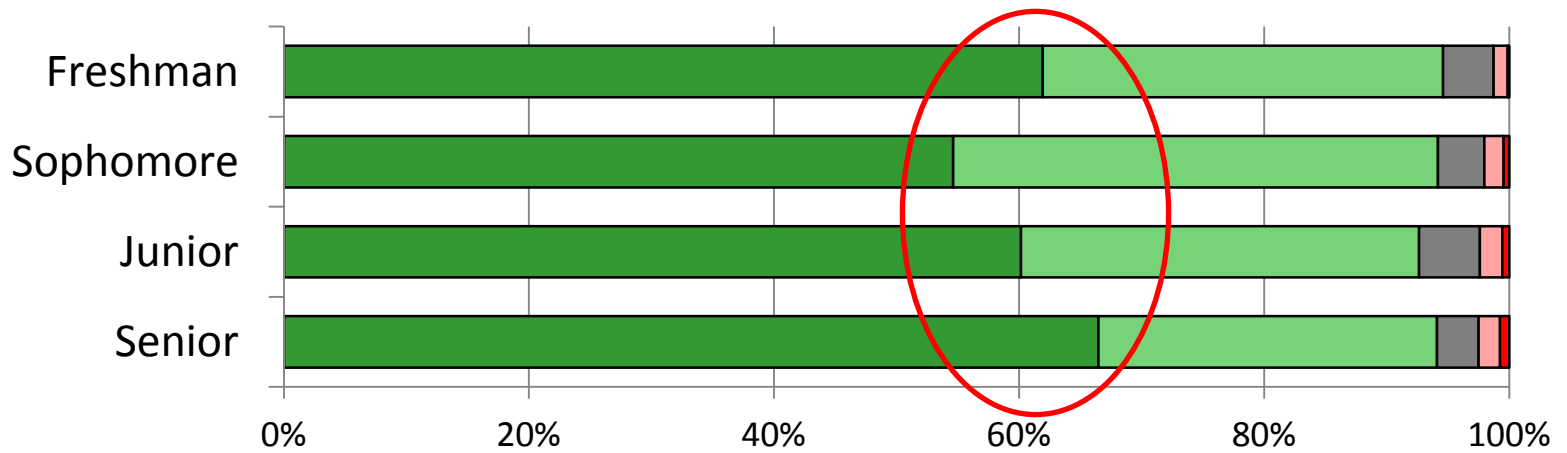

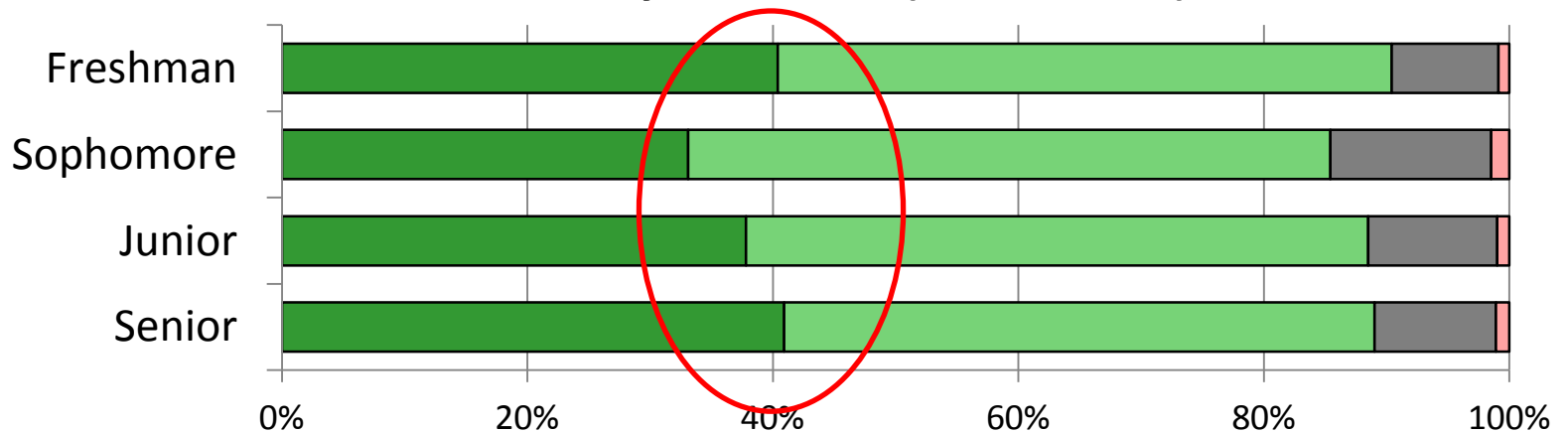

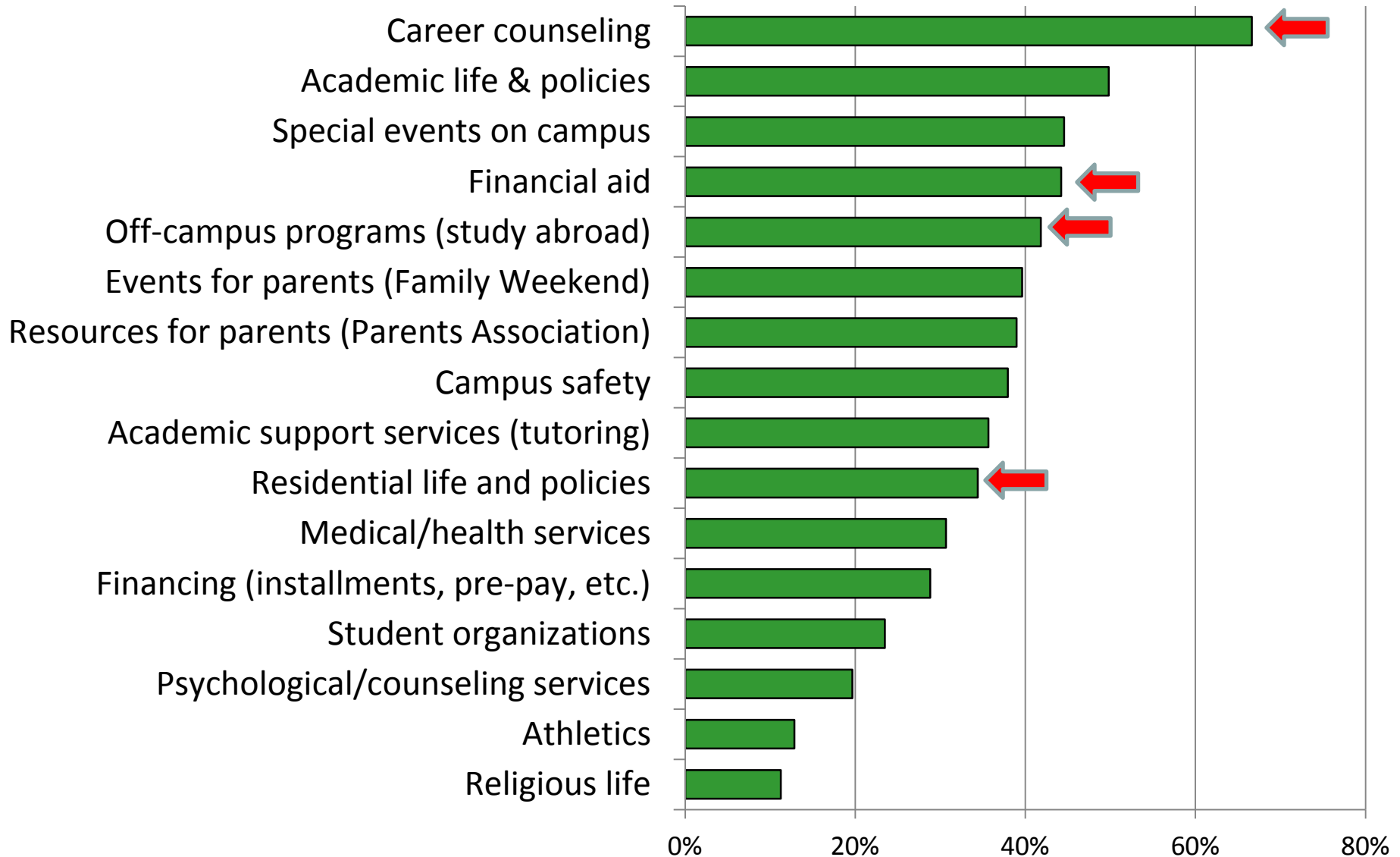


Cornell Students by Class Year (2011 PULSE)

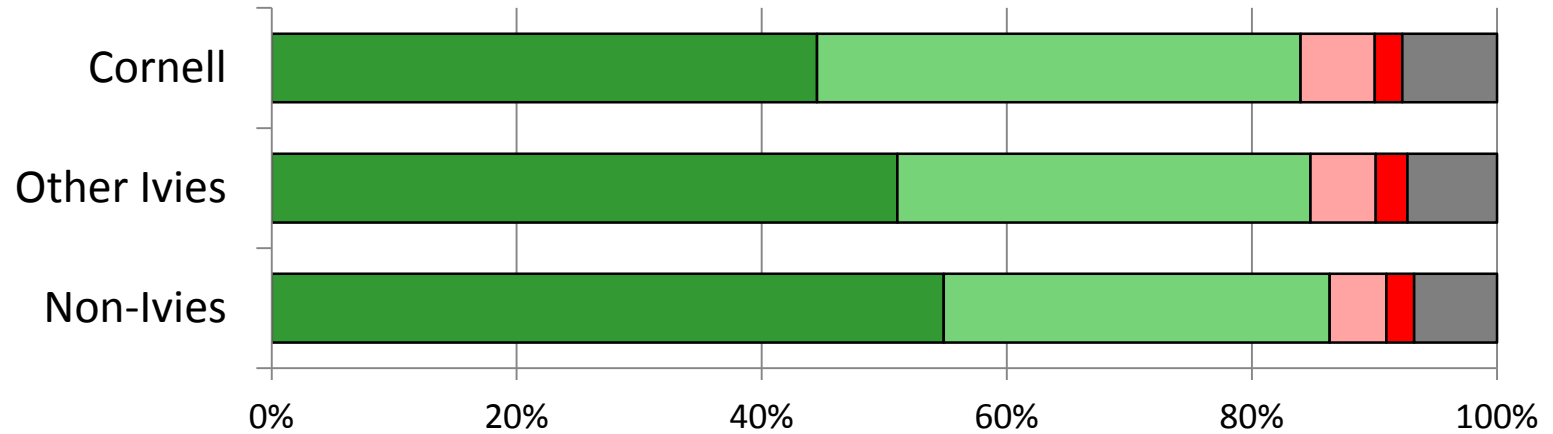

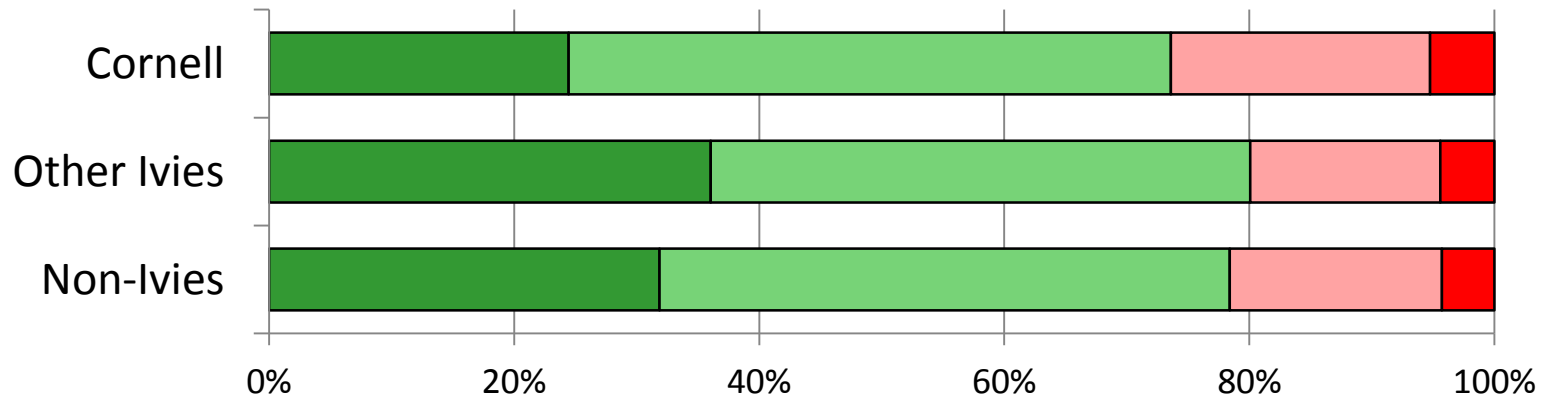
Sense of community on campus

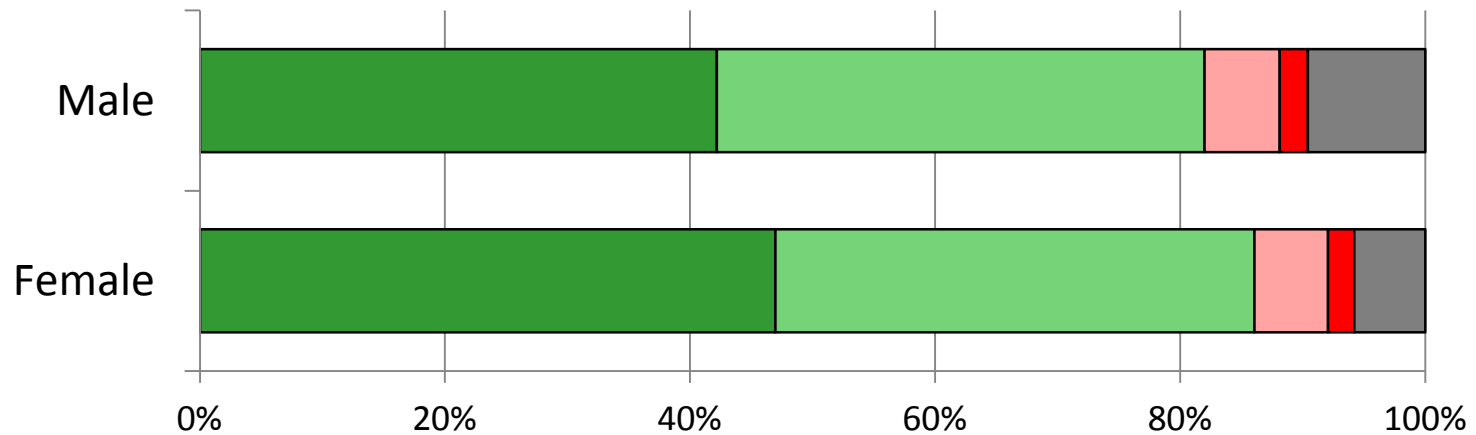

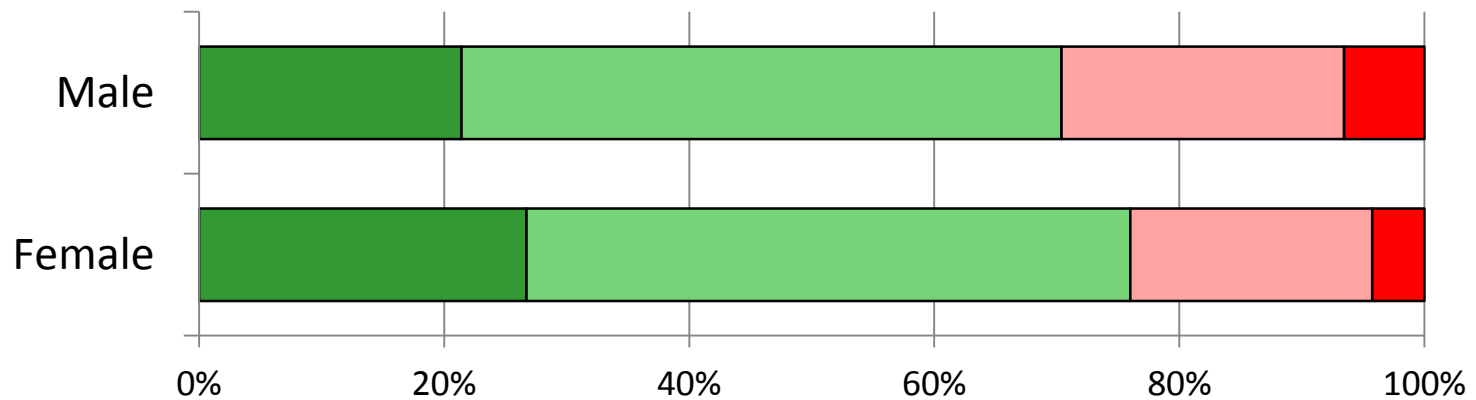

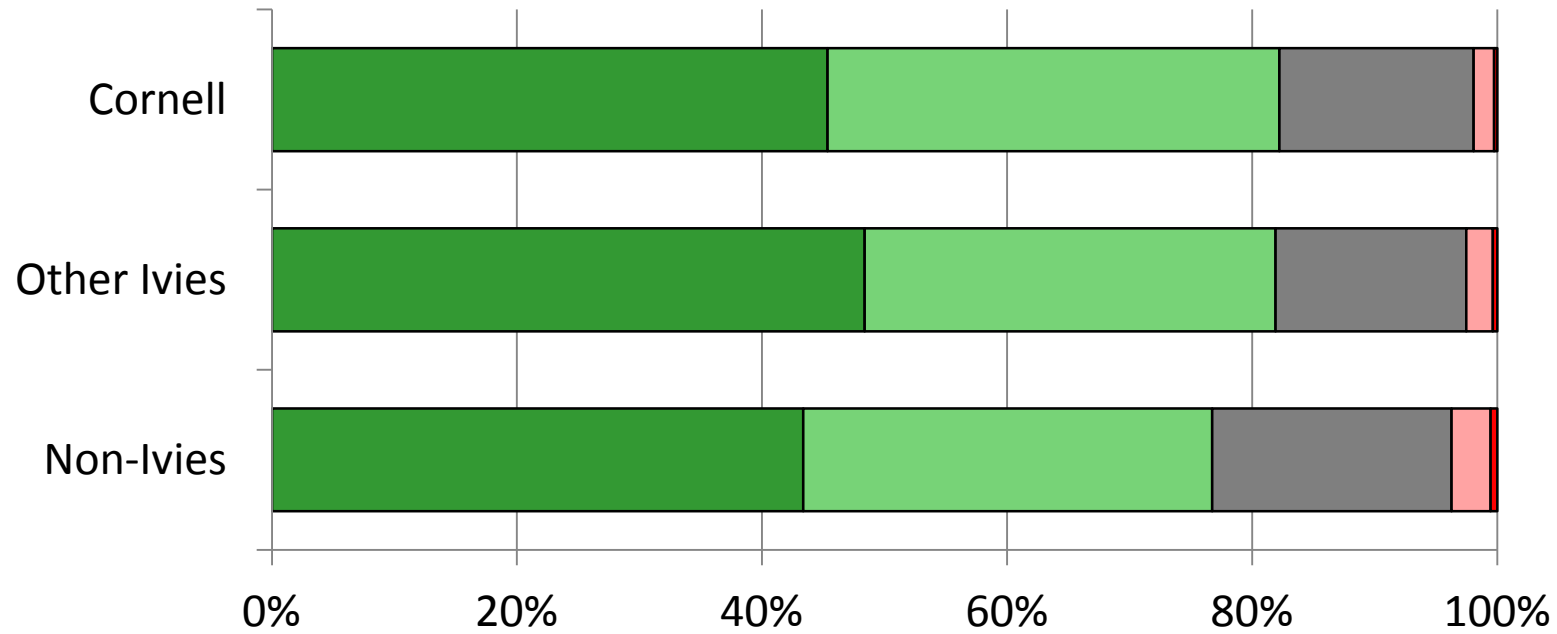
Cornell Students by Sex (2011 PULSE)

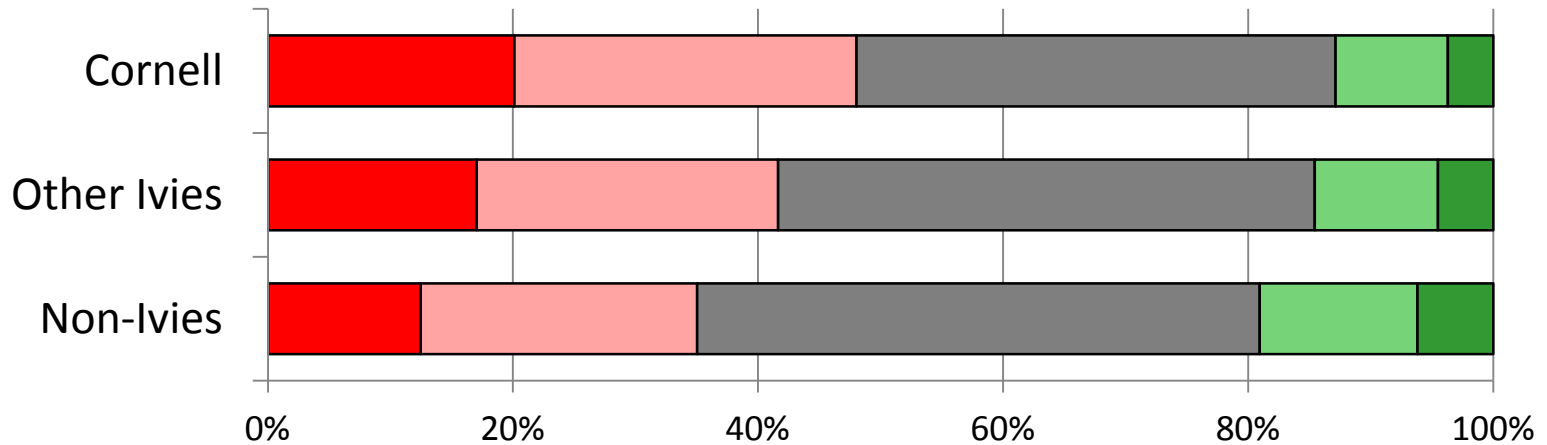

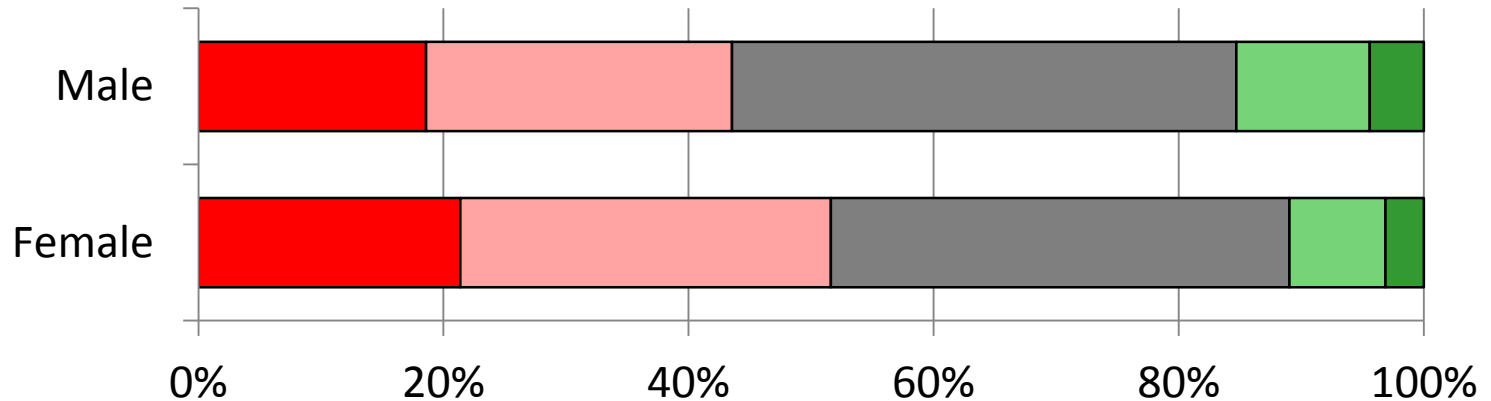
Alcohol plays too dominant a role in social life at Cornell

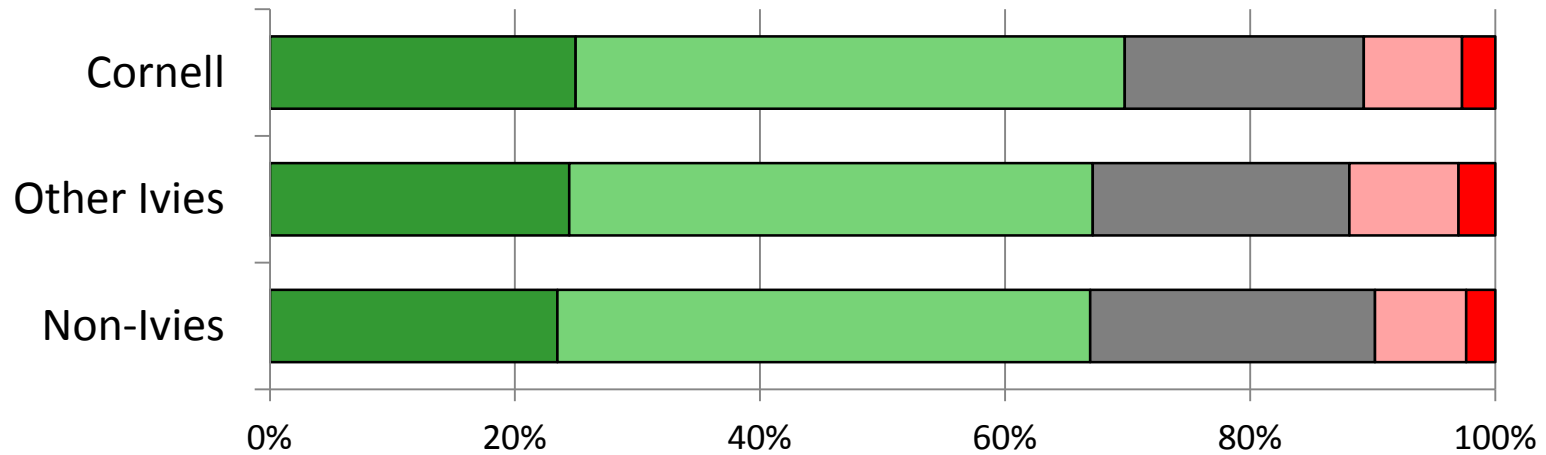

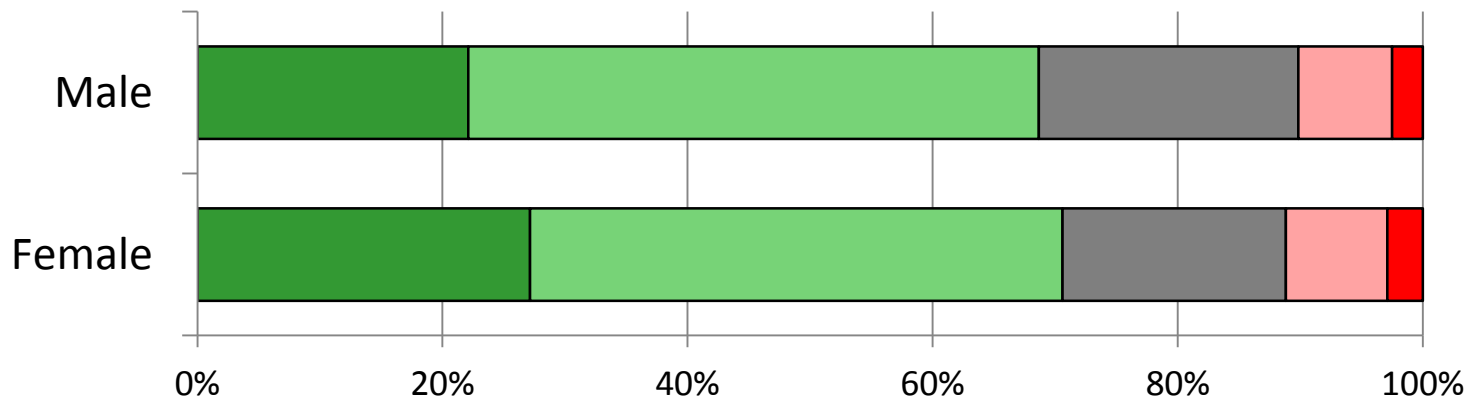
Cornell provides adequate resources for the health and wellness of students

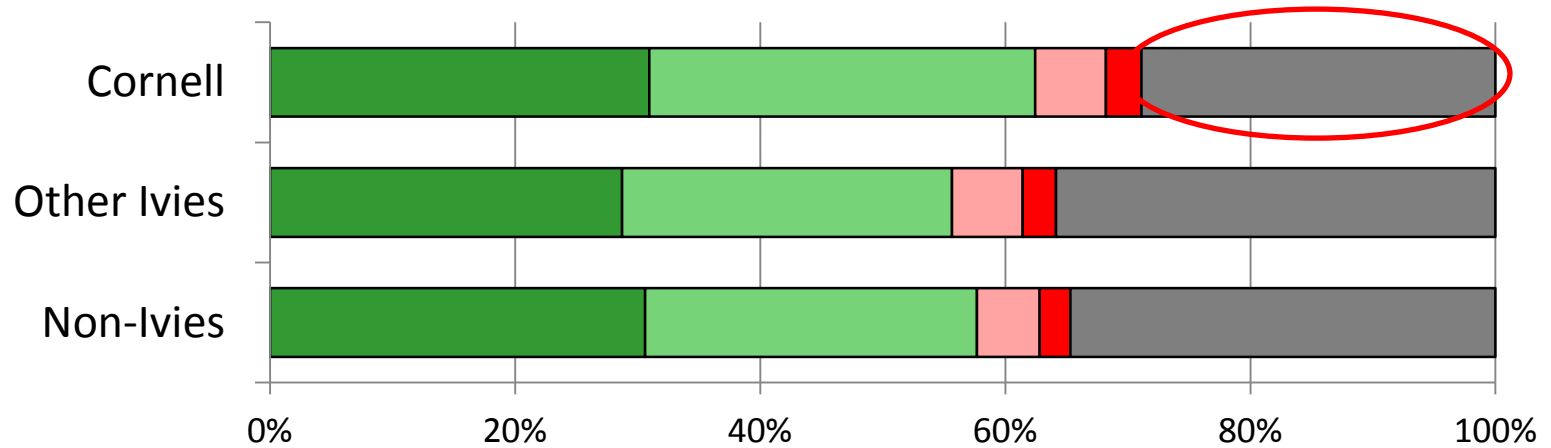

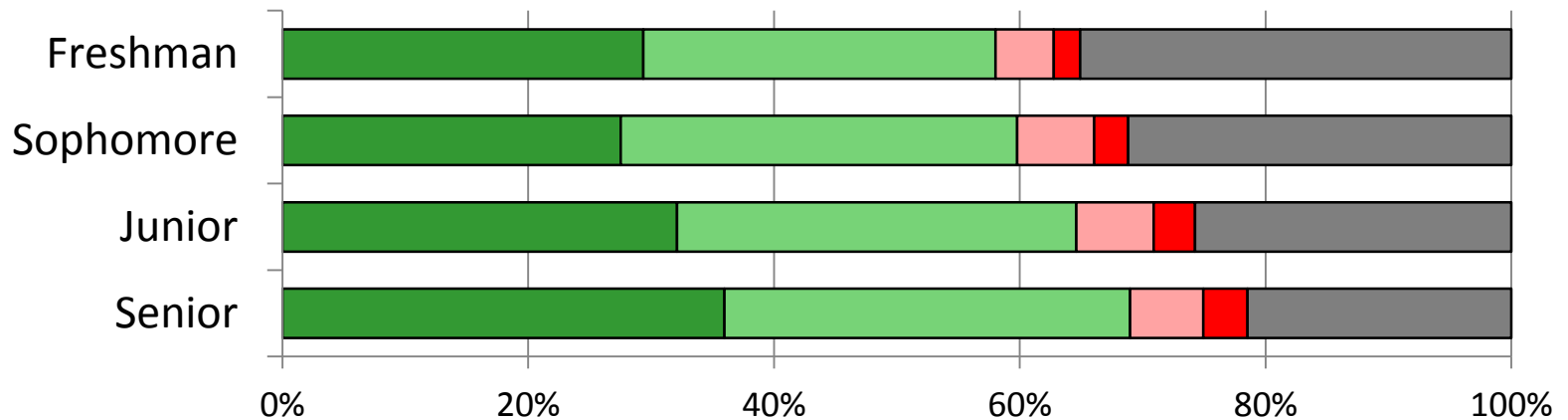

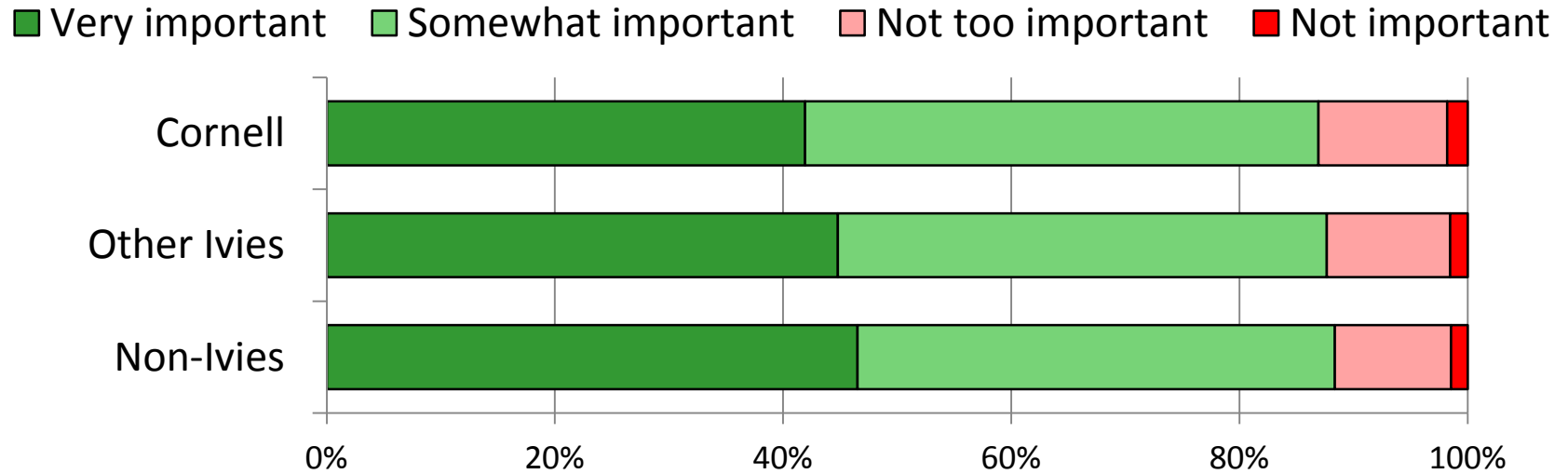


Cornell Parents by Student Class Year

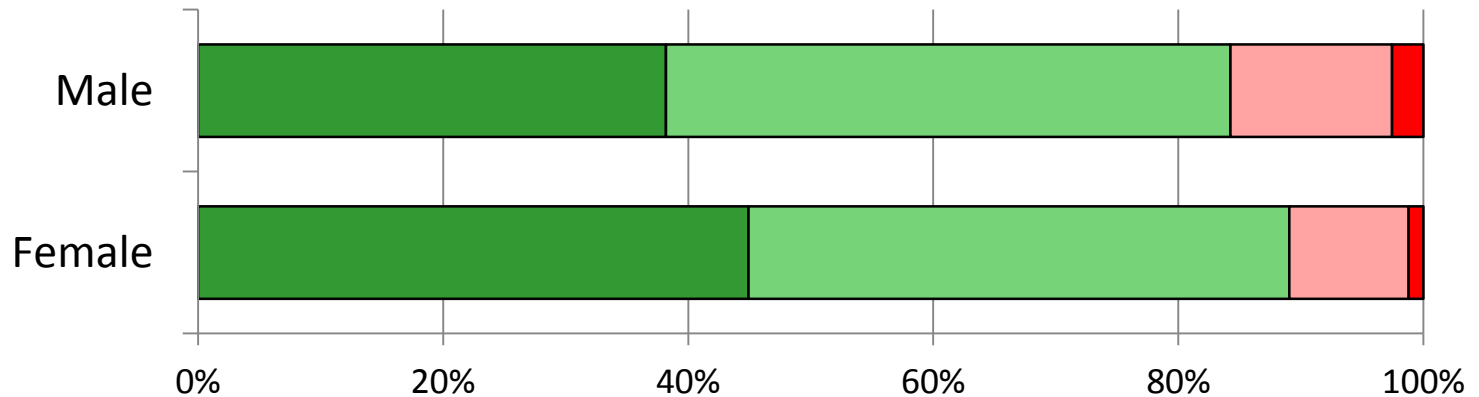


How important is it that Cornell... Encourage community service and volunteering

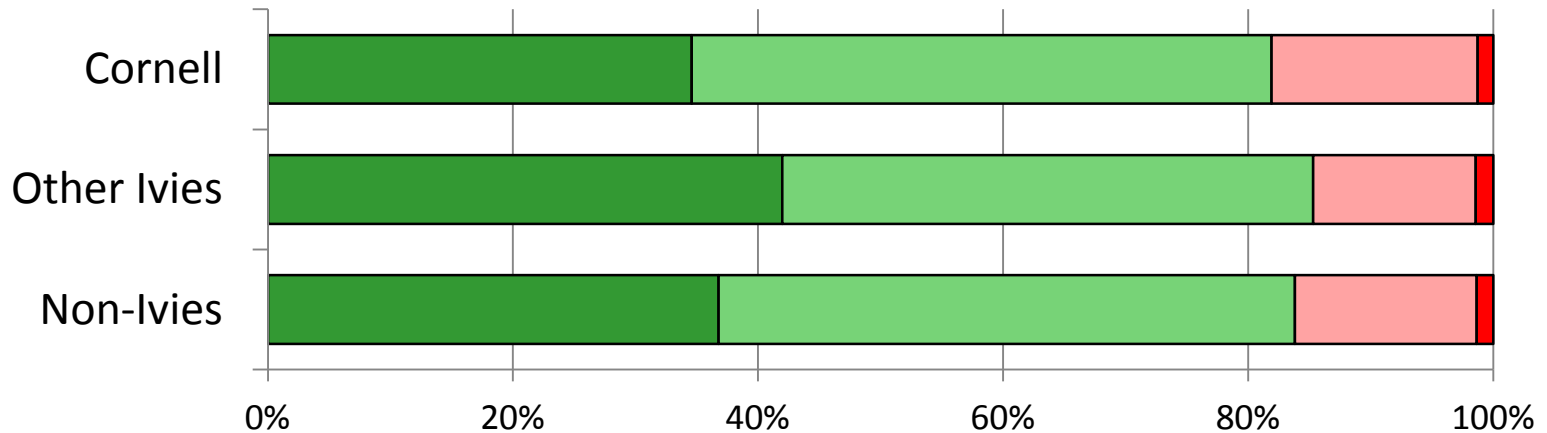
Cornell Parents by Parent Sex



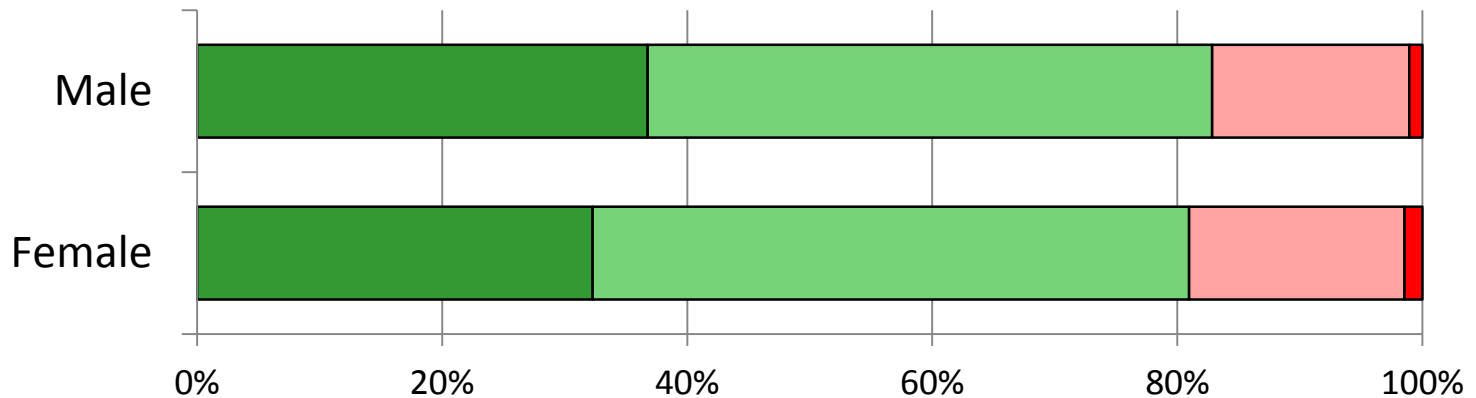
How important is it that Cornell... Provide extensive extracurricular and athletic options

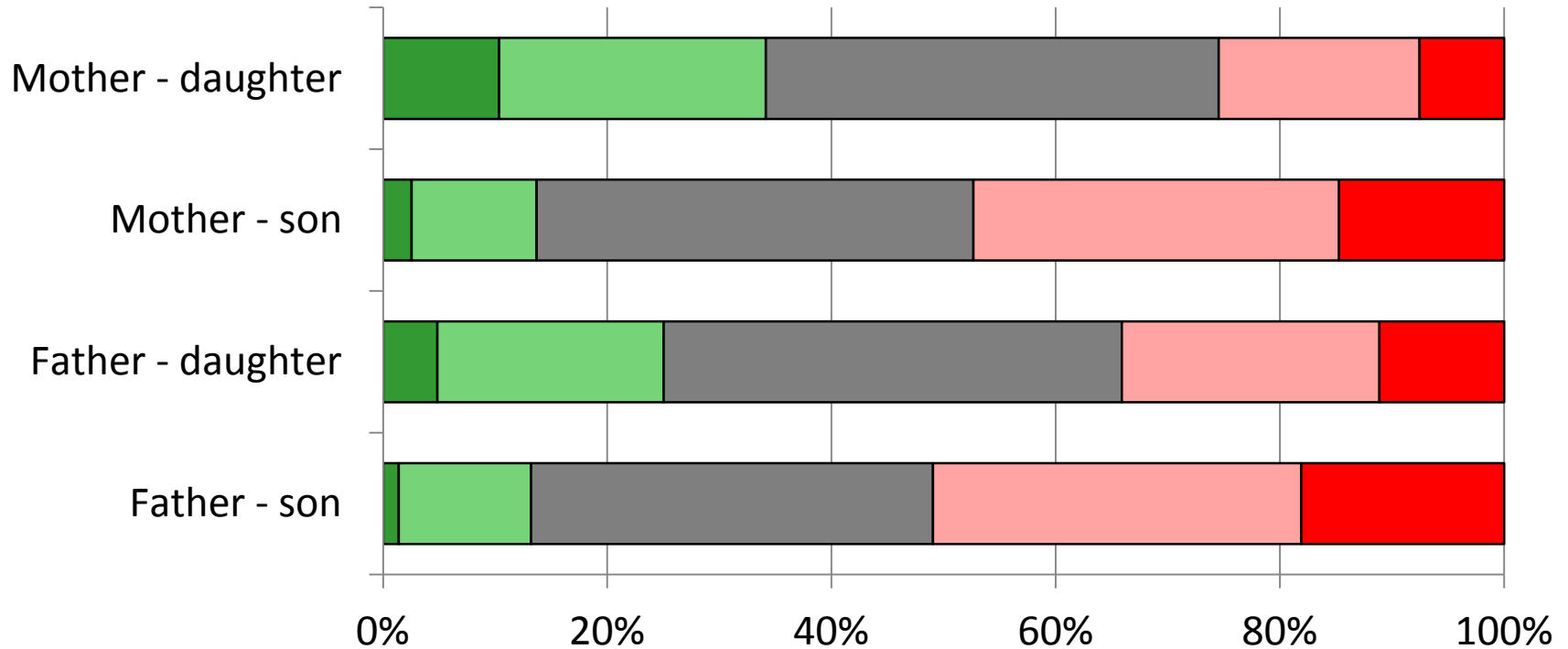


Cornell Parents by Student Sex
