



## **2023 Cornell New Student Survey**

The Cornell New Student Survey asks incoming first-year students about their high school activities; personal goals and abilities; and expectations of their college experience.

This web-based survey was conducted from August 1 to August 25, 2023. All first-time, full-time first-year students at Cornell were invited to respond to the survey. A total of 2,563 first-year students participated in the 2023 New Student Survey, yielding a response rate of 72%.

The results of the 2023 Cornell New Student Survey are displayed in the tables that follow. It may be most useful to refer to the survey instrument first in order to locate questions of interest.

On the first line of each table, the responses for the applicable survey question are presented for Cornell University as a whole. Frequencies are also presented by gender identity, race/ethnicity and citizenship, sexual orientation, and undergraduate college.
